## unit rate

A unit rate is a rate in which the second number (usually written as the denominator) is 1 , or 1 of a quantity. For example, 1.9 children per family, 32 miles per gallon, and 3 flavors of ice cream1 banana split are unit rates. Unit rates are often found by scaling other rates.
